

Beach Competition Instructions

14/02/2010



1. Teams should endeavour to follow the guidelines SLIP SLOP SLAP.
2. Games will be played according to the "Federation of International Touch Beach/Indoor Touch Playing Rules," a copy is at the desk. A copy of the major rule changes is available with this handout.
3. Each team is required to referee during the day.
4. Score sheets need to be returned to the desk by the winning team, no return will result in both teams scoring minus five (-5) touch downs.
5. Points will be allocated 3 for a win, 2 for a draw, 1 for a loss, 0 for a forfeit. A score line of 10-0 will be awarded to the winner of a forfeited game.
6. Ladder positions at the end of the round robin will be determined in the following order, points, wins, most touchdowns for, least touch downs against, result of tie between 2 teams, 3 minute game.
7. In the event of a tie in the semi-finals the highest ranked team before the game will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie in the Grand Final a 3 minute game will begin 1 minute after end of the game. Additional 3 minute games will occur after each extra time until a winner is established.
8. Teams may be penalised 1 touch down per minute where they are not on the field participating in the game.
9. Grand finals will be refereed by at least a level 1 referee appointed by the panel listed in the final point.
10. Voting forms for best dressed team, and the team showing the most sportsmanship need to be handed to the desk by 11am. Presentations for these prizes will be made before the Grand Finals.
11. The winner of the Grand Final will be presented with a cheque for the prize value stipulated in the promotional material. Both presentations will be made following the women's Grand Final.
12. The President, Secretary and Treasurer of AUTC will adjudicate any protests, where one of those is directly involved in any protest, their position shall be taken by an AUTC committee member. Their decision is final.
