



# 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Colley Reserve 5-a-Side Championships

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### 1. Prize Pool

All nominating teams will be competing in the prize pool. The event is strictly limited to 24 teams.

There are 3 divisions on offer. Teams will nominate for a division based on their playing list. Teams will then be re-graded within their divisions after a minimum of three (3) games.

- **Social Division (Div 1)** - (4 players who are current representative players. Would suit current A or B grade teams).
- **Very Social Division (Div 2)** - (2 current representative players allowed. Would suit C – E grade teams)
- **Very, Very Social Division (Div 3)** - (No senior representative players. Would suit E grade teams or below)

\* Representative Player = State League level or higher.

The Total Prize Pool for the 2012 event is \$1400. This is distributed the following ways;

- Winner of Social Division = \$600
- Winner of Very Social Division = \$450
- Winner of Very, Very Social Division = \$350

### 2. Competition Rules & Format

- a. All teams must be mixed. No more than 3 males and no less than 2 females on the field during play.
- b. Teams must nominate a minimum of 7 players
- c. To be eligible to compete players must be participating in a Summer 2011/12 TFA Affiliated competition.
- d. Fields are not full size due to restricted space. In some cases the minimum size field maybe between 40-45m long and 35m wide.
- e. Games are 15 minutes in length (no half time)
- f. TFA 7<sup>th</sup> Edition game rules apply with the exceptions of points d and e above. *All outcomes not included in these conditions will be resolved by these rules or the tournament committee's decision.*

- g. TFSA reserves the right to rule on any situations that arise on a case by case basis.

### **2.1 Points Allocation**

- a. Points will be allocated as 3 for a win and 1 for a loss.
- b. To prevent a drawn situation the first Touchdown will be worth 3 points, all Touchdowns after that will be worth 2 points.
- c. In the grand final each Touchdown will be worth 1 point. In the event of a draw the drop-off rule will be used.

### **3. Uniforms**

**Teams MUST be in uniform.** Uniforms can be fun (such as dress up) but must be consistent. (I.e. matching shirts with number clearly displayed & similar style/color shorts)

Numbers are required on playing shirts

Any players not in uniform will be ineligible to participate in that game.

### **4. Referee Requirements**

**All teams are to nominate 1 referee; entry will be declined without nomination.**

In the event of a team referee not completing their allocated game(s) their team will be deducted 1 point.

### **5. Registration**

- a. Nominations close **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2012 at 5pm.** Late nominations accepted at the discretion of TFSA.
- b. Teams (and/or the team contact) are required to attend the tournament meeting commencing at 8.15am sharp on **Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2012.** Morning of the tournament.
  - i. The final draw will be available at this time
  - ii. Teams will be required to sign in at this time & make any amendments to their team lists
  - iii. Games will commence at 9.00am
  - iv. **All players are required to complete & sign the participant declaration form & submit it prior to their first game**

### **6. Finals Eligibility**

Teams participating in Grand Finals can only play individuals listed on their team sheet as submitted in the tournament briefing. Players can only play for 1 team throughout the course of the day.

If breached teams will be ineligible to claim the cash prize & removed from the competition.

## **7. Showcase Features & Prizes**

When awarding prizes for the winner of the sprint scoop and score race, TFSA's decision is final. All other instructions will be explained on the day.

## **8. Hot/ Wet Weather Policy**

If the forecasted Adelaide Metropolitan temperature exceeds 40 degrees (i.e. 41) on the Bureau of Meteorology website on the Thursday immediately prior to the event – the event will be cancelled. Teams will be notified via email if this occurs.

The event will not be rescheduled and teams will receive a full refund

If the forecast is between 37-40 degrees then games will be reduced in duration with increased breaks scheduled.

The event will go ahead in wet weather unless otherwise advised.

## **9. Competition Costs**

### **Team Fees = \$300 per team**

Once the team nomination form has been accepted, invoices will be created and sent to team contacts for the remainder of the team fee amount.

All teams must be fully financially prior to Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2012. Failure to do so will prohibit participation.

Teams that withdraw after Wednesday the 15<sup>th</sup> of February will **not** receive a refund.

## **10. Event Capacity**

The event is strictly limited to 24 teams.

Teams will be awarded entry based purely on the first 24 nominations received. TFSA will notify teams via email of their status and notify individuals through its website if the capacity is reached.

Teams that miss out on a place maybe placed on a reserve list should a team withdraw from the event.

The vacant position would then be awarded to the 25<sup>th</sup> team that nominated.

## **11. Final Decision**

For all matters arising whether contained in the COE or otherwise, TFSA tournament staff decisions are final.
